



## **FARM LEAGUE ARENA**

Enter the arena of agricultural innovation, where knowledge meets strategy and decisions shape the future of farming. This event is crafted to challenge participants with real-time farm situations, technical problem-solving, economic planning, and resource management, enabling them to think, act, and lead like future-ready farm managers and Agri-entrepreneurs.

### **Rules and Regulations**

Number of entries per college: 1

Number of participants per team: 2

### **Round I - Agri Crossword Challenge**

- Each team will be given a crossword puzzle containing both easy and difficult clues.
- Time allotted: 15 minutes
- Evaluation will be done based on:
  - Time taken to solve the crossword - 5 marks
  - Number of correct answers identified - 5 marks
- Total marks: 10

### **Round II - Real-Time Farm Problem Solving**

- Each team will be given one real-time farm problem.
- Total time allotted: 3 minutes per team
  - 1 minute: Discussion between the two participants
  - 2 minutes: One team member must explain the proposed solution

Participants are expected to provide solutions that are:

- Technically sound
- Economically feasible
- Practical for on-farm implementation

### **Evaluation criteria:**

- Technical approach - 10 marks
- Economic feasibility- 10 marks
- Total marks: 20

### **Selection for Final Round**

- Top 5 teams will be selected for Round III
- Selection will be based on the cumulative score of Round I and II
- In case of a tie, a tie-breaker round will be conducted.

### **Round III - Agri Auction & Farm Planning**

- Each team will be allotted a type of land through lot selection
- A fixed budget will be provided to each team
- Teams must participate in an auction-based bidding process to purchase:
  - Farm implements
  - Farm inputs
  - Farm components

The team placing the highest bid will receive the product.

### **Farm Planning Task:**

Using the purchased products, teams must:

- Prepare a farm plan in a chart
- Clearly depict area allocation
- Show the usage of each purchased component
- Time allotted: 25 minutes
- Explanation time: 5 minutes

### **Evaluation criteria:**

- Proper usage of purchased products - 10 marks
- Overall farm plan - 10 marks
- Explanation - 10 marks
- Total marks: 30

**NOTE:** Chart will be provided and all other necessary stationaries should be brought by the participants
