



## GRAIN ART

### **Introduction:**

Grain art is a unique and creative form of expression that transforms everyday grains-such as cereals, millets and pulses, etc-into beautiful works of art. This eco-friendly art form not only celebrates creativity but also highlights the importance of agriculture and the natural resources.

Participants should create portraits or designs in the base paper and make it artistic that abides by the theme (on spot) using the provided grains.

### **Rules and regulations:**

- 1.Participants must use only grains which will be provided on the spot for creating the artwork.
- 2.Pre coloured grains are not allowed.
- 3.Requirements will be provided (Base sheet, Grains, Fevicol etc).
- 4.The art must be made only using the above-mentioned materials.
- 5.Time limit will be strictly followed.
- 6.Theme will be given on spot (Preparation time will be given 10mins)
- 7.No pre-made designs allowed – artwork must be done on the spot.
- 8.Use of mobile phones / references is not allowed
- 9.Maintain cleanliness in the workspace.
- 10.Any form of copying or external help will lead to disqualification

Number of rounds: 1

Number of participants: 2 per team (single entry per college)

Time period: 1.5 hours

### **Evaluation criteria:**

1. Creativity & Originality

- Uniqueness of the idea and concept
- Innovative use of grains and materials

## 2. Design & Composition

- Arrangement of elements
- Balance, symmetry, and overall visual appeal

## 3. Use of Materials

- Effective and appropriate use of different grains
- Variety in colours, sizes, and textures

## 4. Neatness & Finishing

- Clean work with proper pasting
- No spillage or loose grains

## 5. Relevance to Theme

- How well the artwork reflects the given theme

## 6. Effort & Detailing

- Level of intricacy and time invested
- Fine detailing and precision

## 7. Presentation

- Overall display and explanation of the artwork
- Clarity in describing the concept
